CASHEW INDUSTRY IN TANZANIA

Introduction

The Cashewnut Board of Tanzania (CBT) is a corporate body established by Act No. 18 of 2009. It is entrusted with the responsibility of regulating the development of the Cashew Industry in Tanzania. The main functions of CBT fall under three categories namely; Regulatory, Facilitation, and Promotional functions.

Regulatory functions include:

- > Enforce the implementation of regulations in respect of farming, marketing, processing, transporting and storage of cashew nuts.
- > Collect refine, maintain, use or disseminate information or data concerning the cashewnut industry.
- > Regulate and control the quality of cashewnuts, kernels and cashewnuts by-products.

Facilitation Functions include:-

- > Grant licenses or permits for buying, processing and exporting of cashewnut.
- > Register cashewnuts growers, buyers, sellers, processors and exporters.
- > Appoint inspectors for the inspection of cashewnuts farms, cashewnuts, kernels, premises, processing facilities, warehouses and any other facility.
- Provide the basis or method of pricing of cashewnuts and other products based on market forces.

Promotional Functions include:-

> Promote the quality and competitiveness in the cashewnut industry within and outside Tanzania.

About cashew in Tanzania

Tanzania is among traditional cashew producing countries known for the best quality of Cashew around the world. Cashewnut is the main contributor in the exports basket of Tanzania ranking the first highest export value among main agricultural exports. Production wise Tanzania ranks 8th in the world and 3rd in Africa by 2021/22, aiming to increase the production of raw cashewnut to 700,000 MT by 2026. Currently more than 80% of Cashew is exported in raw form mainly to India and Vietnam, though the Country could gain more if value added products of cashew could be exported. Government currently has set several strategies to ensure 60% of the raw cashewnut is processed locally and have sustainable and reliable market of raw cashewnut, kernels and other products by 2026.

Potential for investment in cashew sector include: establishment of cashew plantations in the country; investment in cashewnut processing factories; establishment of plants for manufacture of pesticides, jute bags and other inputs used in Tanzania as well as investment in the supply of machineries, Equipment and spare parts.
