PUBLIC NOTICE

The Cashewnut Board of Tanzania (CBT) would like to inform the public that, starting from the date of this announcement, February 19, 2025, all contracts related to the purchase, processing, transportation, ownership, and operation of warehouses for raw cashews, cashew kernels, and other cashew derived products must be reviewed and registered by CBT.

Therefore, all stakeholders in the Cashew Industry are reminded that permits and licenses for purchasing, transporting, selling, processing, owning, or operating warehouses, as well as exporting cashews for business purposes, are issued by the Cashewnut Board of Tanzania. The mentioned contracts will not be considered valid until they have been submitted to CBT for review and approval.

Additionally, CBT reminds all stakeholders in the cashew value chain to adhere to the laws, regulations, and guidelines established for the development of the cashew Industry and the nation at large. The Board will not hesitate to take appropriate legal action against any individual, group, institution, or company that fails to comply with these directives.

The Cashewnut Board of Tanzania (CBT) is a government Institution under the Ministry of Agriculture, mandated to oversee the development of the Cashew Industry in the country. It was established under the Cashew Industry Act No. 18 of 2009 and its 2010 Regulations. CBT executes its responsibilities as outlined in Section 5(2)(e), Section 12, and Section 15 of Act No. 18 of 2009 and its 2010 Regulations.
